THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA DISTRICT INTERGROUP REPRESENTATIVE

Each of the Districts served by Northern Virginia Intergroup is asked to elect a District Intergroup Representative. The District Intergroup Representative (DIR) shall serve a term of two years beginning on January 1st. It is recommended that the DIR have at least 2 years of continuous sobriety and has served as an Intergroup Representative (IGR).

The DIR is the communication link between the AA groups in his District and the NVI Board, Officers, Committees, and Office Staff. The DIR is a member of the NVI Board of Directors. Therefore, may vote on all issues discussed at the monthly NVI Board of Directors meeting. As a Trusted Servant, District Intergroup Representatives shall:

- Serve on the Nominating Committee
- Be available for selection and service as a member of the Steering Committee
- Carry information about and from NVI to the groups in his District and bring the informed group conscience of the District to the monthly NVI Board of Director's meeting.
- Be responsible for keeping NVI Office Staff informed, via accurate information, on groups in his District for NVI records and on meetings in his District for publication in the Where and When.
- Encourage groups in his District to elect Intergroup Representatives (IGR)
- Solicit volunteers to serve on NVI Standing Committees from among IGR's or group members in his District.
